MIDWEST INDUSTRIES | AKM VS. YUGO



AKM:

- The AKM is a modernized version of the original AK-47, introduced in the late 1950s by the Soviet Union.
- It was designed to be lighter, simpler to manufacture, and more cost-effective than the original milled-receiver AK-47.
- Produced widely across the Eastern Bloc and beyond under license or as unauthorized copies.

YUGO PATTERN AKS:

- Manufactured by Zastava Arms in the former Yugoslavia (modern-day Serbia).
- Known as the M64, M70, and subsequent variants (e.g., M70AB2, M72, M90).
- These rifles were developed to meet Yugoslavia's specific military needs, leading to several distinctive design features.

RECEIVER DESIGN

AKM:

- Utilizes a stamped sheet-metal receiver (1.0mm thick), which is lighter and faster to produce.
- Reinforcement dimples near the magazine will add structural rigidity.
- Compatible with most standard AK parts and accessories.

YUGO PATTERN AKS:

- Features a thicker 1.5mm stamped receiver or sometimes a milled receiver in earlier models (like the M64).
- No magazine well dimples; instead, it uses a bulged front trunnion for added strength.
- This design contributes to a heavier and more robust rifle, making it better suited for sustained use.

FURNITURE AND DESIGN FEATURES

AKM:

- Traditional wooden furniture (stock, handguards) is used, often with laminated wood for durability.
- Standard-length handguards.
- A slant muzzle brake is standard on most AKMs.
- The gas block is typically basic, without any grenade-launcher-related features.

YUGO PATTERN AKS:

- Larger, more robust wooden furniture (hardwood instead of laminated wood).
- Handguards are longer and not interchangeable with standard AKMs.
- Often equipped with flip-up night sights (tritium inserts in some models).
- Grenade-launching sight/gas cut-off is a standard feature on many models (e.g., M70).
- The under folding stock on Yugo models (like M70AB2) is more robust than standard AKMs but heavier.

BARREL AND TRUNNION

AKM:

- Chrome-lined barrel for corrosion resistance and easier cleaning.
- Standard AKM gas block and front sight block.

YUGO PATTERN AKS:

- Barrels are non-chrome-lined (except in some export models) to improve accuracy, but this requires better maintenance.
- Heavy-duty barrel profile, better suited for sustained fire.
- Gas block and front sight are often unique in appearance, with additional grenade-launching capabilities.

ACCESSORIES AND COMPATIBILITY

AKM:

- Highly compatible with a wide range of AK accessories and magazines due to its standardized design.
- Folding stocks, optics, and other aftermarket parts are widely available.

YUGO PATTERN AKS:

- Uses proprietary parts and furniture due to unique design features, making it not interchangeable with standard AKM parts.
- Magazines with a bolt hold-open follower are standard on Yugo rifles, though they can also use regular AKM mags.

BUILD QUALITY AND DURABILITY

AKM:

- Designed with simplicity and mass production in mind.
- Lighter and slightly less durable than Yugo-pattern rifles in harsh conditions or heavy sustained fire.

YUGO PATTERN AKS:

- Heavier-duty construction, designed for rugged military use.
- Better suited for roles requiring higher durability, such as machine gun variants (e.g., M72 RPK).
